About the University

- Large
 - 6,000+ researchers
- Diverse
 - 3 Faculties comprised of many Schools:
 - Faculty of Biology, Medicine and Health
 - Faculty of Science and Engineering
 - Faculty of Humanities
 - 20+ interdisciplinary research institutes
- Research intensive
 - Research income £391 million



Research Data Management Policy

- **Applies to all research**, whether externally funded or not
- Researchers will produce a **DMP for every research study**
- The Principal Investigator must ensure that a **DMP is written before the research commences, adhered to and updated as necessary** throughout the Study lifecycle
- All DMPs must be recorded and maintained **using the DMPonline service**

Manchester Data Management Outline

Challenge

- Move from in-house DMP tool to DMPonline
- Improve processes and experience for researchers

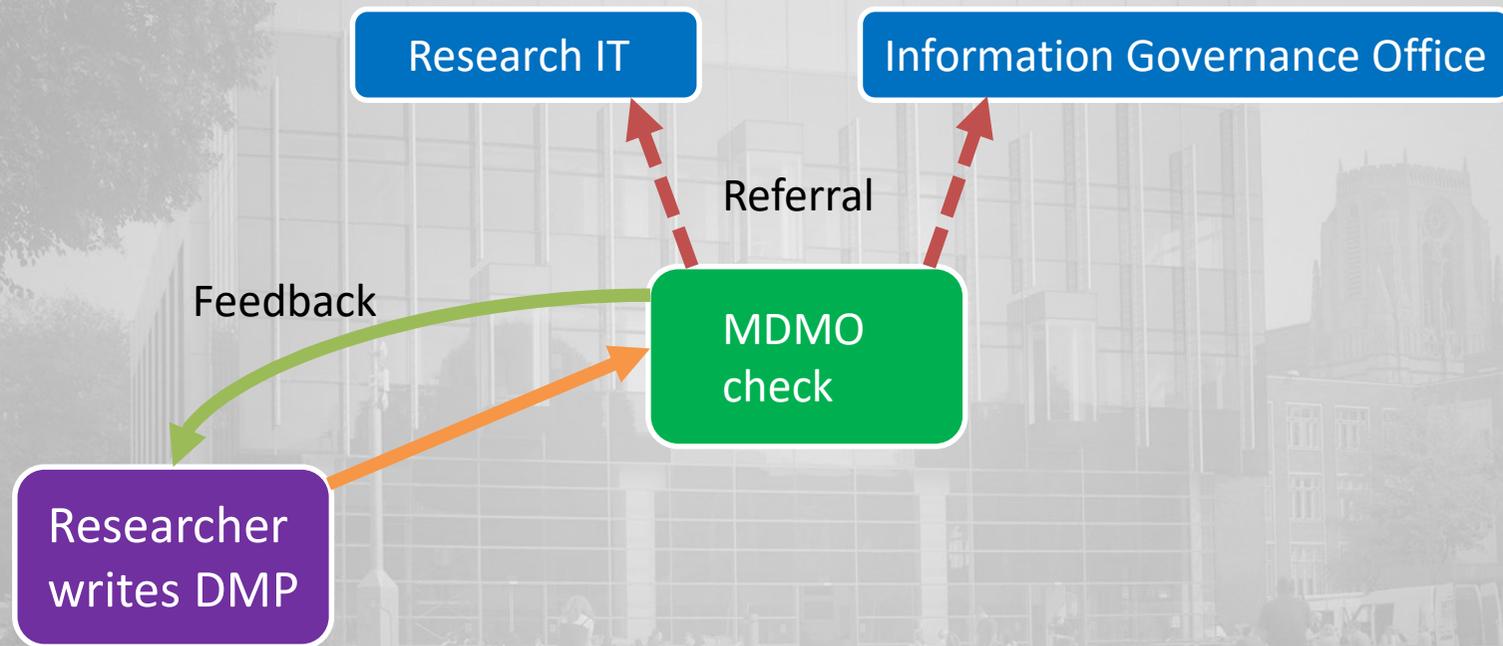
Solution

- Partnership of Professional Services (Library, Information Governance Office, Ethics, Research IT, research support) reviewed research procedures
- Reduce duplication between forms and input from researchers
- Gather information to provide services and inform service development
- Gather information to ensure GDPR compliance

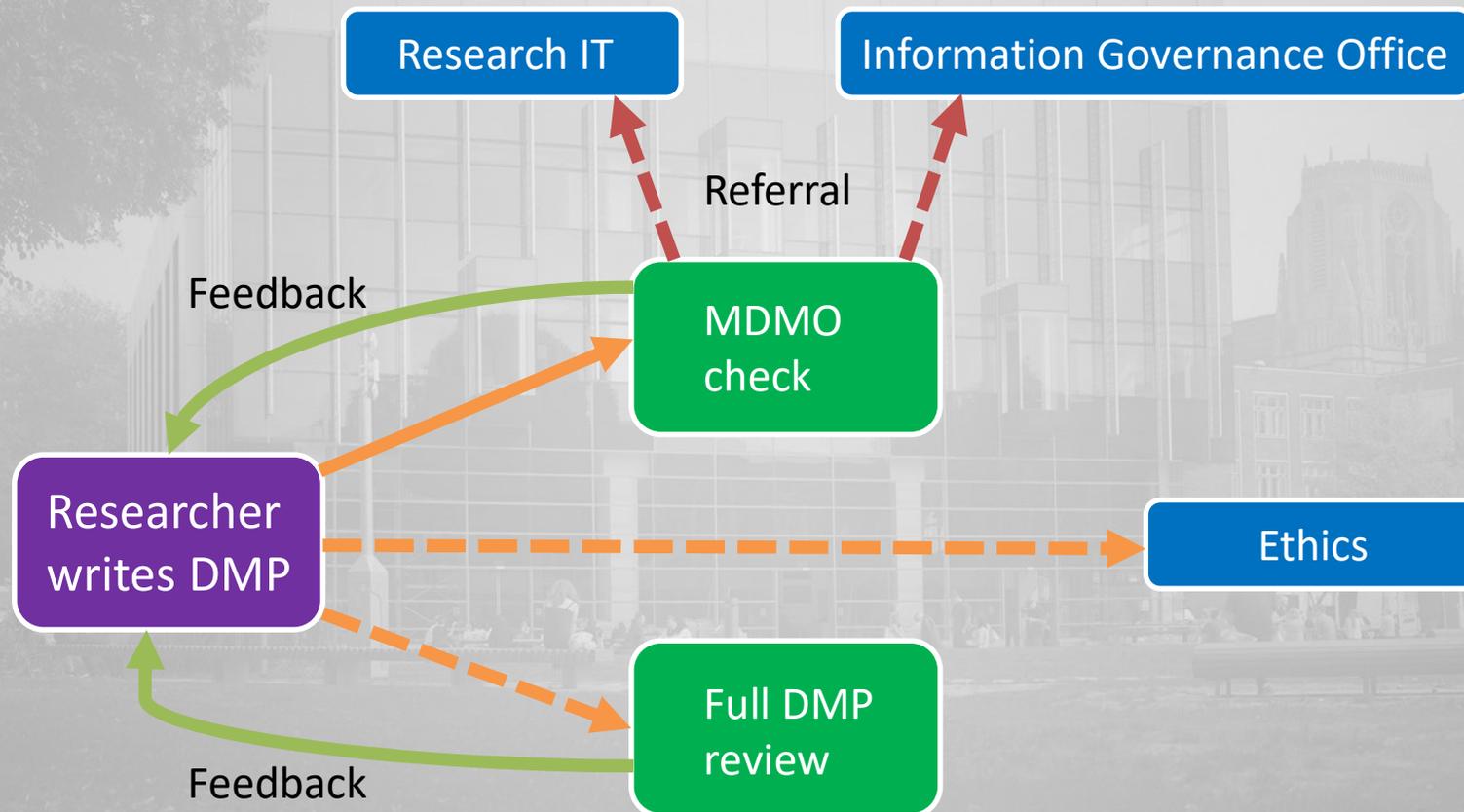
Implementation

- MDMO section prefixes every DMP
- 16 questions, mostly multiple choice, some short text
